- Inadequate onsite parking
- No green space for outdoor play
- A library housed under a stairwell
- Lack of private meeting space
- No soundproof music practice rooms
- 30-year old classrooms
- Middle school classes housed in a separate building
- Inadequate gymnasium with
 - Limited seating
 - No locker rooms
 - No stage or quality audio/video system
 - Lunch requires set-up/tear-down every day.
 - Chapel requires set-up/tear-down every week.
- Opportunities to grow the preschool are by limited space at the 37th Street site
- Inadequate space for flexible all-day, every day early childhood programs

Phase I — Land acquisition and access

Phase II — Early childhood to 8th Grade building

Phase III — Expansion and addition of high school (future project)

Phase I – Purchase 25-30 acres of land.

Estimated cost: \$1 million.

Accommodates future growth of SFLS and LHSSF

Phase II - The building of new facilities—

Estimated cost: \$8 million.
