#### **NEEDS-BASED VARIABLE TUITION APPLICATIONS DUE BY MAY 15**

Thanks to our generous donors who continue to graciously invest in our mission through donations to our <u>needs-based variable tuition</u> fund, we are preparing to award up to \$200,000 in needs-based variable tuition to qualifying families during the 2025-26 school year.

Families that have received variable tuition funds in years past must reapply annually. Applications for the 2025-26 school year are due by May 15, 2025 and must achieve a rating of GOOD to qualify. A GOOD rating simply means that all required documentation has been successfully submitted—to include a finalized 2024 income tax return. Prior year tax returns are not acceptable.

To apply, please log into or create a TADS account for your family at <a href="https://www.mytads.com">www.mytads.com</a> by clicking on "Financial Aid Assessment." TADS will provide a complete list of required documentation before you begin your application, but please know that items like your previous year's tax return are required.

If your family has received funds or wishes to be considered for funding through the <u>South Dakota</u>

<u>Partners in Education (SDPE) tax-credit scholarship program</u>, you must reapply/apply by May 15th using the same TADS application and by selecting funding through both SFLS and SDPE.

Again, please note that submitting an application by the May 15, 2025 deadline does not guarantee a variable tuition award. To be eligible for funding through SFLS and SDPE, your application must achieve a GOOD rating from TADS. They are very good about sending email updates, so once you've applied, watch your email for updates and requests.


Painting will begin early August using high quality/long lasting paint.




