

Launching This Spring: The SFLS K–12 Mentor Program



This spring, we'll begin a new Mentor Program for our Kindergarten through 12th grade students—something rooted deeply in Scripture and inspired by the way Jesus walked so lovingly with His disciples. He taught them, listened to them, encouraged them, and reminded them again and again that they were loved.

Our Mentor Program is designed to pair one caring adult with a student for a simple weekly lunch-time visit. Students are recommended by their classroom teacher, who first connects with parents for permission. From there, our team thoughtfully matches each child with a trained mentor whose gifts and personality fit well. Mentoring isn't about having all the answers—it's about showing up, listening, and helping a child feel valued and seen.

We are now seeking [applications](#) from individuals who feel called to pour into a young person in this meaningful way. If you feel even the slightest nudge, we encourage you to **read the FAQs below** and prayerfully consider whether God may be calling you to invest in a child through this meaningful ministry.

FAQs

What is a mentor?

To put it simply, a mentor is an adult willing to spend time with a student. The mentor shows interest in and cares for the student, listens intently, asks questions, and lets the student know he or she has an extra adult who supports them. All of this is done by simply being present with your student during their lunch break once per week.

Why should you consider being a mentor?

The best reason is that you'll make a lasting impact on the life of a young person. Your consistent presence will mean the world to your student, and he or she will remember what you did for their lifetime.

How do I mentor a student?

There are an endless number of ways to do this, but we would encourage you to utilize the many different games we have available to play together. During the game time, you can get to know each other through natural conversations. Your time, presence, interest, and care are the key elements you are offering when you mentor.

When would I meet with my mentee?

Once you are assigned to a mentee, you will be informed of the time of their lunch break. Looking at your schedule for the week, you then determine which weekday works for you to meet with the student every week at that time.

Where would I meet with my student?

Mentors and mentees will meet in the reading area at SFLS. Games and books are provided for your use.

How do I become a mentor?

Simply complete the [mentor application](#) and authorize a background check. Once approved, you'll be invited to a training session that walks through the program, answers questions, and helps you feel confident and prepared. After training, our team will thoughtfully match you with a student who will benefit from your care.

Re-enrollment window:

Monday, January 12 - Friday, January 23

As a current SFLS family, you receive the *highest enrollment priority*. Because several classes are near capacity and many early childhood classes have large wait pools, **reserving your child's (and any siblings') spot promptly is critical.**

If you have a child who is not currently enrolled or in our wait pool, please follow the instructions below to submit a new student admissions application for 2026–27:

2. Click "Apply/Enroll" in the lefthand navigation bar.
3. Click "Application" in the dropdown menu (a new window will open where you can click "create a new student application").

Application processing for new students begins the week of January 26, after our re-enrollment window for current students closes.

COUNSELING SERVICES

 December brings opportunities for celebration, connection, and fun! But it can also bring stress, grief, and added pressure, especially for families juggling busy schedules or coping with loss.

The holidays are an important time to focus on protective factors such as routines, communication, and connection. These small practices help families manage stress, prevent substance misuse, and support mental wellness!

Tips for the Holiday Season: **Strengthen Routines:** Keep meals, sleep, and downtime as consistent as possible. Predictability helps children and adults stay regulated during busy weeks.

Practice Open Communication: Talk honestly about expectations, finances, schedules, and boundaries. Communication creates a calmer environment. **Reduce Substance-Related Risks:** Offer appealing nonalcoholic drinks and reinforce family rules around youth substance use. Plan for safe transportation. Modeling moderation helps keep celebrations safe. **Acknowledge Grief:** For those missing loved ones, traditions can feel heavy. Encourage people to honor memories, adjust expectations and seek support when needed.


Merry Christmas to you all! We hope everyone has a wonderful break and look forward to seeing you back on January 5.
