



ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Advent - We are now in the season of Advent. What is Advent?

- Advent is a season in the church year where we anticipate the coming/arrival of our Savior Jesus.
- We celebrate Christ coming to us in three ways past, present, future. Christmas and the Old
 Testament prophets tell us how Jesus came to earth in the past. We read about and anticipate
 Christ's second coming on the Last Day. Christ is present with us even now through Word and
 Sacrament and his people, the Body of Christ.

We have an Advent wreath on the altar in chapel. This week we had one candle lit. The first candle is purple and symbolizes hope. It is sometimes called the Prophecy Candle. With this first candle, we remember the hope God's people had in the Old Testament as the prophets declared that a savior would come.

All are welcome to join us at chapel! We look forward to seeing you at the Christmas programs and "music class on the stage." It is fun to celebrate this season with all of our Sioux Falls Lutheran family!


